The mission of Maternal Mental Health NOW is to remove the barriers to prevention, screening and treatment of prenatal and postpartum depression in Los Angeles County. Of the approximately 150,000 live births occurring in LA County each year, over 22,000 birthing people experience clinical perinatal depression, with rates dramatically increasing as a result of the covid pandemic. Left untreated, perinatal depression is linked to detrimental outcomes in the development of the fetus, newborn and developing child.
